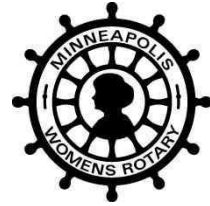

The Minneapolis Women's Rotary (MWR) is a service organization comprised of professional women, entrepreneurs and corporate officers in the greater Twin Cities area. We have been raising money for and supporting local organizations for 113 years. On Saturday, April 13th, 2024, MWR will hold our **39th Annual Benefit Style Show**. This year, we will be hosting the event at the Golden Valley Country Club with silent auctions, raffles and presentations by our sponsors and our charity recipients.

Proceeds from this event will be donated directly to the following three charities that support women in the Twin Cities area:

- **Domestic Abuse Legal Advocacy Center, PSC**

Domestic Abuse Legal Advocacy Center, PSC (DALAC) is a nonprofit law firm that provides pro bono legal services to residents of collaborating Minnesota domestic abuse shelters. Since 2016, through legal advocacy provided by dozens of volunteer attorneys, DALAC has helped resolve legal issues for hundreds of residents and their children.

- **Assistance League Minneapolis/St. Paul**

Assistance League is an all-volunteer nonprofit dedicated to meeting the basic needs of children and families in the Greater Twin Cities area. Since 1996, volunteers have been committed to identifying unmet needs in the local community and addressing them through programs they develop and administer. Currently, Assistance League Minneapolis/St. Paul's nearly 200 member volunteers work to fund and operate eight philanthropic programs in food, clothing, education, and literacy.

- **Lovely's Sewing & Arts Collective**

LSAC is a nonprofit that teaches many forms of art to youth - sewing, yoga, dance, public speaking, entrepreneurship, poetry and so many life skills. These skills are tools to teach patience, focus, leadership, financial literacy and accountability of actions at home, school and in the community.
